



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Deltona-Daytona Beach-Ormond Beach (MSA) [19660]**

Deltona-Daytona Beach-Ormond Beach is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2000 population of 445,041 ranked 101st in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Deltona-Daytona Beach-Ormond Beach had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$23,325. This PCPI ranked 277th in the United States and was 78 percent of the national average, \$29,845. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.1 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Deltona-Daytona Beach-Ormond Beach was \$16,317 and ranked 230th in the United States. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Deltona-Daytona Beach-Ormond Beach had a total personal income (TPI) of \$10,380,740\*. This TPI ranked 119th in the United States. In 1990 the TPI of Deltona-Daytona Beach-Ormond Beach was \$6,105,779\* and ranked 117th in the United States. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 7.7 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Deltona-Daytona Beach-Ormond Beach. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 51.2 percent of TPI (compared with 49.3 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 28.4 percent (compared with 32.5 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 20.3 percent (compared with 18.1 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 7.9 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 9.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.5 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 5.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.7 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Deltona-Daytona Beach-Ormond Beach increased from \$4,784,369\* in 1999 to \$5,078,082\* in 2000, an increase of 6.1 percent. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$3,022,911\* to the 2000 estimate was 5.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
