



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000 Jefferson City (MSA) [27620]**

Jefferson City is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2000 population of 140,328 ranked 262nd in the nation.

### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Jefferson City had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$24,552. This PCPI ranked 216th in the United States and was 82 percent of the national average, \$29,845. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 5.4 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Jefferson City was \$15,899 and ranked 259th in the United States. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Jefferson City had a total personal income (TPI) of \$3,445,286\*. This TPI ranked 254th in the United States. In 1990 the TPI of Jefferson City was \$1,925,512\* and ranked 271st in the United States. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 6.6 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Jefferson City. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 67.5 percent of TPI (compared with 67.8 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 19.1 percent (compared with 19.8 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 13.4 percent (compared with 12.4 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 5.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 9.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 7.1 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 6.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.8 percent.

### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Jefferson City increased from \$2,636,778\* in 1999 to \$2,786,041\* in 2000, an increase of 5.7 percent. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$1,547,455\* to the 2000 estimate was 6.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
