



## **BEARFACTS 1990 – 2000**

### **Utica-Rome (MSA) [46540]**

Utica-Rome is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2000 population of 299,600 ranked 148th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Utica-Rome had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$23,520. This PCPI ranked 270th in the United States and was 79 percent of the national average, \$29,845. The 2000 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.4 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 6.8 percent. In 1990 the PCPI of Utica-Rome was \$16,406 and ranked 223rd in the United States. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2000 Utica-Rome had a total personal income (TPI) of \$7,046,604\*. This TPI ranked 160th in the United States. In 1990 the TPI of Utica-Rome was \$5,201,848\* and ranked 136th in the United States. The 2000 TPI reflected an increase of 4.3 percent from 1999. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The 1990-2000 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Utica-Rome. In 2000 net earnings accounted for 60.9 percent of TPI (compared with 63.4 in 1990); dividends, interest, and rent were 18.0 percent (compared with 19.3 in 1990); and personal current transfer receipts were 21.1 percent (compared with 17.4 in 1990). From 1999 to 2000 net earnings increased 4.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 5.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.0 percent. From 1990 to 2000 net earnings increased on average 2.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.1 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Utica-Rome increased from \$4,660,605\* in 1999 to \$4,846,139\* in 2000, an increase of 4.0 percent. The 1999-2000 national change was 8.0 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1990 estimate of \$3,735,017\* to the 2000 estimate was 2.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
