



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Boise City-Nampa (MSA) [14260]**

Boise City-Nampa is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2001 population of 485,676 ranked 95th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Boise City-Nampa had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$28,986. This PCPI ranked 110th in the United States and was 95 percent of the national average, \$30,574. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 1.3 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 2.4 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Boise City-Nampa was \$17,972 and ranked 153rd in the United States. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Boise City-Nampa had a total personal income (TPI) of \$14,077,946\*. This TPI ranked 92nd in the United States. In 1991 the TPI of Boise City-Nampa was \$6,027,319\* and ranked 122nd in the United States. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 4.9 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 8.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Boise City-Nampa. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 71.5 percent of TPI (compared with 70.0 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 17.7 percent (compared with 18.7 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 10.7 percent (compared with 11.3 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 4.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 4.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 12.3 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 9.1 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 8.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 8.3 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Boise City-Nampa increased from \$10,919,103\* in 2000 to \$11,307,041\* in 2001, an increase of 3.6 percent. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$4,785,744\* to the 2001 estimate was 9.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
