



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Bradenton-Sarasota-Venice (MSA) [14600]**

Bradenton-Sarasota-Venice is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2001 population of 605,070 ranked 78th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Bradenton-Sarasota-Venice had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$37,034. This PCPI ranked 19th in the United States and was 121 percent of the national average, \$30,574. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.4 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 2.4 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Bradenton-Sarasota-Venice was \$24,067 and ranked 13th in the United States. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Bradenton-Sarasota-Venice had a total personal income (TPI) of \$22,408,089\*. This TPI ranked 62nd in the United States. In 1991 the TPI of Bradenton-Sarasota-Venice was \$12,156,464\* and ranked 67th in the United States. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 6.6 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Bradenton-Sarasota-Venice. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 47.6 percent of TPI (compared with 41.9 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 37.5 percent (compared with 42.4 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 14.8 percent (compared with 15.7 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 7.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 4.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 8.4 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 7.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.7 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Bradenton-Sarasota-Venice increased from \$10,383,588\* in 2000 to \$11,265,134\* in 2001, an increase of 8.5 percent. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$5,379,041\* to the 2001 estimate was 7.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
