



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville (MSA) [40900]**

Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2001 population of 1,867,476 ranked 26th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$30,807. This PCPI ranked 74th in the United States and was 101 percent of the national average, \$30,574. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.7 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 2.4 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville was \$20,264 and ranked 71st in the United States. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville had a total personal income (TPI) of \$57,531,729\*. This TPI ranked 28th in the United States. In 1991 the TPI of Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville was \$31,753,717\* and ranked 28th in the United States. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 6.1 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 69.0 percent of TPI (compared with 68.2 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 17.0 percent (compared with 18.2 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 14.0 percent (compared with 13.5 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 5.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 12.9 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 6.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.5 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville increased from \$41,926,701\* in 2000 to \$44,540,173\* in 2001, an increase of 6.2 percent. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$24,162,259\* to the 2001 estimate was 6.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
