



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Shreveport-Bossier City (MSA) [43340]**

Shreveport-Bossier City is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2001 population of 375,982 ranked 122nd in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Shreveport-Bossier City had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$25,526. This PCPI ranked 211th in the United States and was 83 percent of the national average, \$30,574. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 5.9 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 2.4 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Shreveport-Bossier City was \$16,769 and ranked 227th in the United States. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Shreveport-Bossier City had a total personal income (TPI) of \$9,597,504\*. This TPI ranked 131st in the United States. In 1991 the TPI of Shreveport-Bossier City was \$6,015,649\* and ranked 123rd in the United States. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 5.9 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Shreveport-Bossier City. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 64.7 percent of TPI (compared with 64.0 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 17.7 percent (compared with 20.0 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 17.7 percent (compared with 16.1 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 6.4 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 0.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 11.3 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 4.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Shreveport-Bossier City increased from \$6,801,794\* in 2000 to \$7,223,133\* in 2001, an increase of 6.2 percent. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$4,373,707\* to the 2001 estimate was 5.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
