



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Austin-Round Rock (BEA-EA) [57013]**

Austin-Round Rock is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 2001 population of 1,431,553 ranked 56th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Austin-Round Rock had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$31,449. This PCPI ranked 20th in the United States and was 103 percent of the national average, \$30,574. The 2001 PCPI reflected a decrease of 1.1 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 2.4 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Austin-Round Rock was \$18,179 and ranked 52nd in the United States. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Austin-Round Rock had a total personal income (TPI) of \$45,020,258\*. This TPI ranked 47th in the United States. In 1991 the TPI of Austin-Round Rock was \$17,463,077\* and ranked 66th in the United States. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 3.3 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 9.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Austin-Round Rock. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 77.0 percent of TPI (compared with 71.4 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 15.1 percent (compared with 19.1 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 7.9 percent (compared with 9.6 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 2.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 11.8 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 10.8 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 7.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Austin-Round Rock increased from \$37,832,970\* in 2000 to \$38,837,604\* in 2001, an increase of 2.7 percent. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$13,812,018\* to the 2001 estimate was 10.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
