



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Pendleton-Hermiston (BEA-EA) [57124]**

Pendleton-Hermiston is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 2001 population of 140,503 ranked 173rd in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Pendleton-Hermiston had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$21,977. This PCPI ranked 164th in the United States and was 72 percent of the national average, \$30,574. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.6 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 2.4 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Pendleton-Hermiston was \$15,061 and ranked 153rd in the United States. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Pendleton-Hermiston had a total personal income (TPI) of \$3,087,791\*. This TPI ranked 175th in the United States. In 1991 the TPI of Pendleton-Hermiston was \$1,902,056\* and ranked 175th in the United States. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 1.8 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Pendleton-Hermiston. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 57.6 percent of TPI (compared with 59.6 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 21.7 percent (compared with 22.6 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 20.6 percent (compared with 17.8 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings decreased 0.1 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 0.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 10.4 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 4.6 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.5 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Pendleton-Hermiston decreased from \$2,053,269\* in 2000 to \$2,046,345\* in 2001, a decrease of 0.3 percent. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$1,265,973\* to the 2001 estimate was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
