



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Sioux City-Vermillion (BEA-EA) [57154]**

Sioux City-Vermillion is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 2001 population of 379,755 ranked 130th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Sioux City-Vermillion had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$25,077. This PCPI ranked 94th in the United States and was 82 percent of the national average, \$30,574. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.4 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 2.4 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Sioux City-Vermillion was \$16,517 and ranked 99th in the United States. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Sioux City-Vermillion had a total personal income (TPI) of \$9,523,196\*. This TPI ranked 129th in the United States. In 1991 the TPI of Sioux City-Vermillion was \$6,061,700\* and ranked 127th in the United States. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 3.0 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Sioux City-Vermillion. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 63.7 percent of TPI (compared with 63.4 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 20.7 percent (compared with 21.8 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 15.6 percent (compared with 14.8 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 1.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 3.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 8.2 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 4.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.2 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Sioux City-Vermillion increased from \$6,692,664\* in 2000 to \$6,801,297\* in 2001, an increase of 1.6 percent. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$4,288,989\* to the 2001 estimate was 4.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
