



## **BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002**

### **Santa Cruz , Arizona [04023]**

Santa Cruz is one of 15 counties in Arizona. It is part of the Nogales, AZ Micropolitan SA. Its 2002 population of 39,292 ranked 12th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Santa Cruz had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$17,275. This PCPI ranked 12th in the state and was 65 percent of the state average, \$26,474, and 56 percent of the national average, \$30,821. The 2002 PCPI reflected a decrease of 1.7 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.1 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Santa Cruz was \$12,568 and ranked 12th in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.1 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Santa Cruz had a total personal income (TPI) of \$678,762\*. This TPI ranked 12th in the state and accounted for 0.5 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of Santa Cruz was \$402,251\* and ranked 12th in the state. The 2002 TPI reflected a decrease of 0.7 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 3.8 percent and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.6 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Santa Cruz. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 58.2 percent of TPI (compared with 61.2 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 20.0 percent (compared with 21.1 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 21.8 percent (compared with 17.7 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings decreased 1.9 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 9.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 13.0 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 4.8 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Santa Cruz decreased from \$507,664\* in 2001 to \$493,352\* in 2002, a decrease of 2.8 percent. The 2001-2002 state change was 3.6 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$293,398\* to the 2002 estimate was 5.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 8.0 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
