



BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002

Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood (MSA) [28660]

Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2002 population of 340,113 ranked 138th in the nation.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2002 Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$24,134. This PCPI ranked 292nd in the United States and was 78 percent of the national average, \$30,821. The 2002 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.7 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood was \$16,538 and ranked 302nd in the United States. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.0 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2002 Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood had a total personal income (TPI) of \$8,208,370*. This TPI ranked 154th in the United States. In 1992 the TPI of Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood was \$4,477,173* and ranked 161st in the United States. The 2002 TPI reflected an increase of 5.5 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.2 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 73.7 percent of TPI (compared with 72.9 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 13.1 percent (compared with 14.7 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 13.3 percent (compared with 12.4 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings increased 6.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 5.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 11.7 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 6.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.0 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood increased from \$6,140,453* in 2001 to \$6,579,948* in 2002, an increase of 7.2 percent. The 2001-2002 national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$3,659,022* to the 2002 estimate was 6.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.4 percent.
