



## **BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002 Garfield , Nebraska [31071]**

Garfield is one of 93 counties in Nebraska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2002 population of 1,869 ranked 79th in the state.

### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Garfield had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$25,173. This PCPI ranked 27th in the state and was 86 percent of the state average, \$29,203, and 82 percent of the national average, \$30,821. The 2002 PCPI reflected a decrease of 1.2 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.8 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Garfield was \$14,686 and ranked 78th in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Garfield had a total personal income (TPI) of \$47,049\*. This TPI ranked 77th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of Garfield was \$30,856\* and ranked 80th in the state. The 2002 TPI reflected a decrease of 1.4 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 2.2 percent and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Garfield. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 42.8 percent of TPI (compared with 50.8 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 34.1 percent (compared with 30.3 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 23.1 percent (compared with 18.8 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings decreased 0.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 6.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.8 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 2.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.5 percent.

### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Garfield decreased from \$21,761\* in 2001 to \$21,739\* in 2002, a decrease of 0.1 percent. The 2001-2002 state change was 2.2 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$17,519\* to the 2002 estimate was 2.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
