



## **BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002**

### **Emmons , North Dakota [38029]**

Emmons is one of 53 counties in North Dakota. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2002 population of 4,065 ranked 30th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Emmons had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$18,986. This PCPI ranked 43rd in the state and was 72 percent of the state average, \$26,415, and 62 percent of the national average, \$30,821. The 2002 PCPI reflected a decrease of 14.1 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 2.1 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Emmons was \$14,557 and ranked 42nd in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 2.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.1 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Emmons had a total personal income (TPI) of \$77,177\*. This TPI ranked 32nd in the state and accounted for 0.5 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of Emmons was \$67,703\* and ranked 32nd in the state. The 2002 TPI reflected a decrease of 16.6 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.7 percent and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 1.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Emmons. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 40.9 percent of TPI (compared with 55.1 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 32.2 percent (compared with 23.8 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 26.9 percent (compared with 21.1 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings decreased 33.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 1.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.2 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings decreased on average 1.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 3.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Emmons decreased from \$51,988\* in 2001 to \$35,991\* in 2002, a decrease of 30.8 percent. The 2001-2002 state change was 2.4 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$39,789\* to the 2002 estimate was - 1.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
