



## **BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002 McCurtain , Oklahoma [40089]**

McCurtain is one of 77 counties in Oklahoma. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2002 population of 33,931 ranked 29th in the state.

### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 McCurtain had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$20,258. This PCPI ranked 50th in the state and was 78 percent of the state average, \$25,872, and 66 percent of the national average, \$30,821. The 2002 PCPI reflected a decrease of 1.2 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was -0.6 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of McCurtain was \$13,598 and ranked 57th in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.1 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 McCurtain had a total personal income (TPI) of \$687,379\*. This TPI ranked 29th in the state and accounted for 0.8 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of McCurtain was \$455,564\* and ranked 26th in the state. The 2002 TPI reflected a decrease of 1.5 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change remained unchanged and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of McCurtain. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 62.7 percent of TPI (compared with 63.8 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 10.9 percent (compared with 11.4 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 26.4 percent (compared with 24.8 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings decreased 2.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 16.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 10.0 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 4.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.8 percent.

### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in McCurtain decreased from \$498,790\* in 2001 to \$484,740\* in 2002, a decrease of 2.8 percent. The 2001-2002 state change was - 0.3 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$329,332\* to the 2002 estimate was 3.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
