



## **BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002**

### **Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario (MSA) [40140]**

Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2002 population of 3,490,698 ranked 14th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$24,107. This PCPI ranked 295th in the United States and was 78 percent of the national average, \$30,821. The 2002 PCPI reflected an increase of 1.3 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario was \$17,797 and ranked 214th in the United States. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario had a total personal income (TPI) of \$84,150,669\*. This TPI ranked 20th in the United States. In 1992 the TPI of Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario was \$50,211,247\* and ranked 19th in the United States. The 2002 TPI reflected an increase of 4.7 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 68.9 percent of TPI (compared with 68.7 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 14.5 percent (compared with 15.5 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 16.6 percent (compared with 15.8 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings increased 6.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 5.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 8.6 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 5.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario increased from \$48,070,149\* in 2001 to \$51,608,229\* in 2002, an increase of 7.4 percent. The 2001-2002 national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$27,868,852\* to the 2002 estimate was 6.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.4 percent.
