



## **BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002**

### **Jones , South Dakota [46075]**

Jones is one of 66 counties in South Dakota. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2002 population of 1,126 ranked 66th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Jones had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$22,349. This PCPI ranked 36th in the state and was 83 percent of the state average, \$27,029, and 73 percent of the national average, \$30,821. The 2002 PCPI reflected a decrease of 17.5 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 0.4 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Jones was \$19,229 and ranked 7th in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 1.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Jones had a total personal income (TPI) of \$25,165\*. This TPI ranked 63rd in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of Jones was \$24,459\* and ranked 63rd in the state. The 2002 TPI reflected a decrease of 18.7 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 0.8 percent and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 0.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.0 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Jones. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 54.5 percent of TPI (compared with 61.3 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 29.2 percent (compared with 26.9 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 16.3 percent (compared with 11.8 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings decreased 29.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 2.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.3 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings decreased on average 0.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 3.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Jones decreased from \$21,183\* in 2001 to \$15,500\* in 2002, a decrease of 26.8 percent. The 2001-2002 state change was 0.2 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$16,004\* to the 2002 estimate was - 0.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
