



BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002

Ellis , Texas [48139]

Ellis is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is part of the [Dallas-Fort Worth-Arlington, TX \(MSA\)](#). Its 2002 population of 119,622 ranked 28th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2002 Ellis had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$27,039. This PCPI ranked 41st in the state and was 94 percent of the state average, \$28,835, and 88 percent of the national average, \$30,821. The 2002 PCPI reflected a decrease of 0.9 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was -0.7 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Ellis was \$17,620 and ranked 64th in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2002 Ellis had a total personal income (TPI) of \$3,234,453*. This TPI ranked 27th in the state and accounted for 0.5 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of Ellis was \$1,556,056* and ranked 34th in the state. The 2002 TPI reflected an increase of 2.4 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.1 percent and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 7.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.4 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Ellis. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 75.3 percent of TPI (compared with 71.0 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 9.7 percent (compared with 12.5 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 15.0 percent (compared with 16.5 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings increased 1.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 9.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 20.2 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 8.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.6 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Ellis increased from \$1,369,705* in 2001 to \$1,412,197* in 2002, an increase of 3.1 percent. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.0 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$776,775* to the 2002 estimate was 6.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.8 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
