



## **BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002**

### **Llano , Texas [48299]**

Llano is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2002 population of 17,729 ranked 127th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Llano had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$23,197. This PCPI ranked 104th in the state and was 80 percent of the state average, \$28,835, and 75 percent of the national average, \$30,821. The 2002 PCPI reflected an increase of 0.2 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was -0.7 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Llano was \$16,955 and ranked 80th in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Llano had a total personal income (TPI) of \$411,263\*. This TPI ranked 122nd in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of Llano was \$209,188\* and ranked 136th in the state. The 2002 TPI reflected an increase of 1.8 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.1 percent and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 7.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.4 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Llano. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 49.9 percent of TPI (compared with 36.8 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 25.4 percent (compared with 35.6 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 24.6 percent (compared with 27.6 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings increased 3.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 6.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 7.1 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 10.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Llano increased from \$144,808\* in 2001 to \$153,341\* in 2002, an increase of 5.9 percent. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.0 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$76,815\* to the 2002 estimate was 7.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.8 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
