



## **BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002**

### **Sutton , Texas [48435]**

Sutton is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2002 population of 4,081 ranked 209th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Sutton had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$22,276. This PCPI ranked 128th in the state and was 77 percent of the state average, \$28,835, and 72 percent of the national average, \$30,821. The 2002 PCPI reflected an increase of 5.8 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was -0.7 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Sutton was \$15,999 and ranked 114th in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Sutton had a total personal income (TPI) of \$90,908\*. This TPI ranked 207th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of Sutton was \$66,733\* and ranked 210th in the state. The 2002 TPI reflected an increase of 6.9 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.1 percent and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.4 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Sutton. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 60.8 percent of TPI (compared with 59.2 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 21.6 percent (compared with 26.4 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 17.7 percent (compared with 14.3 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings increased 14.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 10.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 9.3 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 3.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.4 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Sutton increased from \$61,430\* in 2001 to \$70,483\* in 2002, an increase of 14.7 percent. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.0 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$48,221\* to the 2002 estimate was 3.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.8 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
