



## **BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002 Crook , Wyoming [56011]**

Crook is one of 23 counties in Wyoming. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2002 population of 5,870 ranked 21st in the state.

### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Crook had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$29,482. This PCPI ranked 9th in the state and was 95 percent of the state average, \$31,101, and 96 percent of the national average, \$30,821. The 2002 PCPI reflected a decrease of 0.4 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 2.4 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Crook was \$19,866 and ranked 4th in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Crook had a total personal income (TPI) of \$173,059\*. This TPI ranked 21st in the state and accounted for 1.1 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of Crook was \$107,378\* and ranked 20th in the state. The 2002 TPI reflected an increase of 1.7 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 3.3 percent and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.5 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Crook. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 68.5 percent of TPI (compared with 66.7 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 18.9 percent (compared with 21.5 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 12.6 percent (compared with 11.8 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings increased 6.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 15.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.5 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 5.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.6 percent.

### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Crook increased from \$85,492\* in 2001 to \$91,564\* in 2002, an increase of 7.1 percent. The 2001-2002 state change was 3.6 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$59,153\* to the 2002 estimate was 4.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.1 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
