



## **BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003**

### **San Bernardino , California [06071]**

San Bernardino is one of 58 counties in California. It is part of the [Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario, CA \(MSA\)](#). Its 2003 population of 1,853,248 ranked 4th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 San Bernardino had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$23,987. This PCPI ranked 44th in the state and was 71 percent of the state average, \$33,554, and 76 percent of the national average, \$31,504. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.7 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 2.2 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of San Bernardino was \$17,323 and ranked 43rd in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 San Bernardino had a total personal income (TPI) of \$44,452,948\*. This TPI ranked 7th in the state and accounted for 3.7 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of San Bernardino was \$26,841,013\* and ranked 6th in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 5.5 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.4 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.3 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of San Bernardino. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 72.2 percent of TPI (compared with 71.1 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 10.9 percent (compared with 12.4 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 17.0 percent (compared with 16.6 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 6.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 0.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.8 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 5.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.4 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in San Bernardino increased from \$27,570,015\* in 2002 to \$29,648,177\* in 2003, an increase of 7.5 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 4.0 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$16,072,734\* to the 2003 estimate was 6.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.6 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.
