



BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003

Kearny , Kansas [20093]

Kearny is one of 105 counties in Kansas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2003 population of 4,349 ranked 74th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 Kearny had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$21,846. This PCPI ranked 95th in the state and was 73 percent of the state average, \$29,802, and 69 percent of the national average, \$31,504. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 5.2 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 2.8 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Kearny was \$22,338 and ranked 13th in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was - 0.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.9 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 Kearny had a total personal income (TPI) of \$95,007*. This TPI ranked 80th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of Kearny was \$93,059* and ranked 73rd in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 3.0 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.2 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 0.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.6 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Kearny. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 68.2 percent of TPI (compared with 73.9 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 15.7 percent (compared with 16.0 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 16.1 percent (compared with 10.1 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 10.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 18.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 1.7 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings decreased on average 0.6 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent remained unchanged; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.0 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Kearny increased from \$52,256* in 2002 to \$58,834* in 2003, an increase of 12.6 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 5.0 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$63,828* to the 2003 estimate was - 0.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.0 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.
