



## **BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003 Frontier , Nebraska [31063]**

Frontier is one of 93 counties in Nebraska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2003 population of 2,890 ranked 71st in the state.

### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Frontier had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$26,317. This PCPI ranked 48th in the state and was 86 percent of the state average, \$30,778, and 84 percent of the national average, \$31,504. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 35.1 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 5.4 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Frontier was \$17,588 and ranked 47th in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.5 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Frontier had a total personal income (TPI) of \$76,055<sup>\*</sup>. This TPI ranked 70th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of Frontier was \$54,628<sup>\*</sup> and ranked 72nd in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 31.2 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 6.0 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Frontier. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 66.1 percent of TPI (compared with 65.2 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 17.9 percent (compared with 20.4 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 16.0 percent (compared with 14.5 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 56.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 1.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 1.2 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 3.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.4 percent.

### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Frontier increased from \$28,617<sup>\*</sup> in 2002 to \$46,648<sup>\*</sup> in 2003, an increase of 63.0 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 7.5 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$33,123<sup>\*</sup> to the 2003 estimate was 3.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.
