



## **BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003**

### **Emmons , North Dakota [38029]**

Emmons is one of 53 counties in North Dakota. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2003 population of 3,964 ranked 31st in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Emmons had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$24,484. This PCPI ranked 41st in the state and was 85 percent of the state average, \$28,712, and 78 percent of the national average, \$31,504. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 29.0 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 8.7 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Emmons was \$14,724 and ranked 44th in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.0 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Emmons had a total personal income (TPI) of \$97,054<sup>\*</sup>. This TPI ranked 31st in the state and accounted for 0.5 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of Emmons was \$68,156<sup>\*</sup> and ranked 30th in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 25.8 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 8.6 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Emmons. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 53.0 percent of TPI (compared with 54.6 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 24.7 percent (compared with 23.5 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 22.3 percent (compared with 21.9 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 63.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 3.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.2 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 3.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 3.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Emmons increased from \$35,991<sup>\*</sup> in 2002 to \$55,936<sup>\*</sup> in 2003, an increase of 55.4 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 12.2 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$40,086<sup>\*</sup> to the 2003 estimate was 3.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.3 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.
