



## **BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003**

### **Coleman , Texas [48083]**

Coleman is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2003 population of 8,729 ranked 176th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Coleman had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$21,330. This PCPI ranked 183rd in the state and was 73 percent of the state average, \$29,404, and 68 percent of the national average, \$31,504. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.2 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 2.0 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Coleman was \$15,161 and ranked 171st in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Coleman had a total personal income (TPI) of \$186,188\*. This TPI ranked 175th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of Coleman was \$144,481\* and ranked 170th in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 4.6 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.6 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 2.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.2 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Coleman. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 45.2 percent of TPI (compared with 48.4 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 18.6 percent (compared with 19.5 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 36.2 percent (compared with 32.1 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 6.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.1 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 1.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 3.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Coleman increased from \$67,982\* in 2002 to \$72,880\* in 2003, an increase of 7.2 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.5 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$67,797\* to the 2003 estimate was 0.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.5 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.
