



## **BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003**

### **Ector , Texas [48135]**

Ector is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is part of the [Odessa, TX \(MSA\)](#). Its 2003 population of 122,195 ranked 28th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Ector had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$22,841. This PCPI ranked 140th in the state and was 78 percent of the state average, \$29,404, and 73 percent of the national average, \$31,504. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.1 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 2.0 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Ector was \$15,593 and ranked 157th in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Ector had a total personal income (TPI) of \$2,791,096\*. This TPI ranked 32nd in the state and accounted for 0.4 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of Ector was \$1,886,974\* and ranked 28th in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 3.4 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.6 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.2 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Ector. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 66.5 percent of TPI (compared with 67.0 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 13.5 percent (compared with 15.6 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 20.0 percent (compared with 17.4 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 2.9 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.9 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 3.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.5 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Ector increased from \$2,075,071\* in 2002 to \$2,141,937\* in 2003, an increase of 3.2 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.5 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$1,403,874\* to the 2003 estimate was 4.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.5 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
