



## **BEARFACTS 1994 – 2004 Greenlee , Arizona [04011]**

Greenlee is one of 15 counties in Arizona. It is part of the Safford, AZ Micropolitan SA. Its 2004 population of 7,320 ranked 15th in the state.

### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Greenlee had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$24,085. This PCPI ranked 5th in the state and was 84 percent of the state average, \$28,710, and 73 percent of the national average, \$33,123. The 2004 PCPI reflected an increase of 10.5 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 6.4 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. In 1994 the PCPI of Greenlee was \$15,731 and ranked 6th in the state. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.1 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.

### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Greenlee had a total personal income (TPI) of \$176,299\*. This TPI ranked 15th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1994 the TPI of Greenlee was \$138,482\* and ranked 15th in the state. The 2004 TPI reflected an increase of 9.4 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 9.5 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of TPI was 2.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.3 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Greenlee. In 2004 net earnings accounted for 65.8 percent of TPI (compared with 70.5 in 1994); dividends, interest, and rent were 8.0 percent (compared with 10.8 in 1994); and personal current transfer receipts were 26.2 percent (compared with 18.6 in 1994). From 2003 to 2004 net earnings increased 10.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 3.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 10.0 percent. From 1994 to 2004 net earnings increased on average 1.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 0.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.0 percent.

### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Greenlee increased from \$176,709\* in 2003 to \$196,150\* in 2004, an increase of 11.0 percent. The 2003-2004 state change was 9.3 percent and the national change was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1994 estimate of \$150,790\* to the 2004 estimate was 2.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.7 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
