



BEARFACTS 1994 – 2004

Bradenton-Sarasota-Venice (MSA) [14600]

Bradenton-Sarasota-Venice is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2004 population of 649,670 ranked 77th in the nation.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2004 Bradenton-Sarasota-Venice had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$40,632. This PCPI ranked 17th in the United States and was 123 percent of the national average, \$33,123. The 2004 PCPI reflected an increase of 9.9 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 national change was 5.1 percent. In 1994 the PCPI of Bradenton-Sarasota-Venice was \$26,700 and ranked 15th in the United States. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.1 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2004 Bradenton-Sarasota-Venice had a total personal income (TPI) of \$26,397,649*. This TPI ranked 60th in the United States. In 1994 the TPI of Bradenton-Sarasota-Venice was \$14,210,672* and ranked 66th in the United States. The 2004 TPI reflected an increase of 13.0 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 national change was 6.1 percent. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.2 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Bradenton-Sarasota-Venice. In 2004 net earnings accounted for 46.9 percent of TPI (compared with 43.7 in 1994); dividends, interest, and rent were 37.9 percent (compared with 39.7 in 1994); and personal current transfer receipts were 15.3 percent (compared with 16.7 in 1994). From 2003 to 2004 net earnings increased 9.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 20.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 7.3 percent. From 1994 to 2004 net earnings increased on average 7.1 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.5 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Bradenton-Sarasota-Venice increased from \$11,836,889* in 2003 to \$13,019,607* in 2004, an increase of 10.0 percent. The 2003-2004 national change was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1994 estimate of \$6,699,710* to the 2004 estimate was 6.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.5 percent.
