



## **BEARFACTS 1994 – 2004**

### **Lane , Kansas [20101]**

Lane is one of 105 counties in Kansas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2004 population of 1,904 ranked 102nd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Lane had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$25,191. This PCPI ranked 51st in the state and was 81 percent of the state average, \$30,995, and 76 percent of the national average, \$33,123. The 2004 PCPI reflected a decrease of 22.5 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 4.0 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. In 1994 the PCPI of Lane was \$22,680 and ranked 10th in the state. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 1.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Lane had a total personal income (TPI) of \$47,964\*. This TPI ranked 101st in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1994 the TPI of Lane was \$52,550\* and ranked 99th in the state. The 2004 TPI reflected a decrease of 24.1 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 4.3 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of TPI was - 0.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.6 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Lane. In 2004 net earnings accounted for 50.1 percent of TPI (compared with 61.7 in 1994); dividends, interest, and rent were 26.1 percent (compared with 23.3 in 1994); and personal current transfer receipts were 23.8 percent (compared with 15.0 in 1994). From 2003 to 2004 net earnings decreased 37.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 6.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts decreased 0.9 percent. From 1994 to 2004 net earnings decreased on average 2.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 0.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 3.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Lane decreased from \$41,746\* in 2003 to \$27,452\* in 2004, a decrease of 34.2 percent. The 2003-2004 state change was 5.7 percent and the national change was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1994 estimate of \$35,176\* to the 2004 estimate was - 2.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.0 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
