



BEARFACTS 1994 – 2004

Pershing , Nevada [32027]

Pershing is one of 17 counties in Nevada. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2004 population of 6,330 ranked 11th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2004 Pershing had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$19,394. This PCPI ranked 17th in the state and was 56 percent of the state average, \$34,442, and 59 percent of the national average, \$33,123. The 2004 PCPI reflected an increase of 14.4 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 8.3 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. In 1994 the PCPI of Pershing was \$16,161 and ranked 17th in the state. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 1.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.8 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2004 Pershing had a total personal income (TPI) of \$122,767*. This TPI ranked 13th in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. In 1994 the TPI of Pershing was \$77,991* and ranked 13th in the state. The 2004 TPI reflected an increase of 13.7 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 12.7 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 8.5 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Pershing. In 2004 net earnings accounted for 66.7 percent of TPI (compared with 71.2 in 1994); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.8 percent (compared with 15.8 in 1994); and personal current transfer receipts were 16.6 percent (compared with 13.0 in 1994). From 2003 to 2004 net earnings increased 13.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 17.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 10.1 percent. From 1994 to 2004 net earnings increased on average 4.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.2 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Pershing increased from \$87,591* in 2003 to \$92,972* in 2004, an increase of 6.1 percent. The 2003-2004 state change was 11.6 percent and the national change was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1994 estimate of \$64,977* to the 2004 estimate was 3.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 8.2 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
