



## **BEARFACTS 1994 – 2004**

### **Mahoning , Ohio [39099]**

Mahoning is one of 88 counties in Ohio. It is part of the [Youngstown-Warren-Boardman, OH-PA \(MSA\)](#). Its 2004 population of 248,309 ranked 10th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Mahoning had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$27,541. This PCPI ranked 34th in the state and was 90 percent of the state average, \$30,744, and 83 percent of the national average, \$33,123. The 2004 PCPI reflected an increase of 1.7 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 3.1 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. In 1994 the PCPI of Mahoning was \$20,336 and ranked 30th in the state. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.5 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Mahoning had a total personal income (TPI) of \$6,838,628\*. This TPI ranked 11th in the state and accounted for 1.9 percent of the state total. In 1994 the TPI of Mahoning was \$5,406,780\* and ranked 10th in the state. The 2004 TPI reflected an increase of 0.8 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 3.2 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of TPI was 2.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.8 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Mahoning. In 2004 net earnings accounted for 61.4 percent of TPI (compared with 61.3 in 1994); dividends, interest, and rent were 15.1 percent (compared with 17.8 in 1994); and personal current transfer receipts were 23.5 percent (compared with 20.9 in 1994). From 2003 to 2004 net earnings increased 1.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 5.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.1 percent. From 1994 to 2004 net earnings increased on average 2.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 0.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 3.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Mahoning increased from \$4,339,211\* in 2003 to \$4,481,429\* in 2004, an increase of 3.3 percent. The 2003-2004 state change was 4.1 percent and the national change was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1994 estimate of \$3,309,937\* to the 2004 estimate was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
