



BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005

Aleutians West Census Area , Alaska [02016]

Aleutians West Census Area is one of 27 counties in Alaska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2005 population of 5,359 ranked 19th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2005 Aleutians West Census Area had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$28,501. This PCPI ranked 20th in the state and was 79 percent of the state average, \$36,261, and 82 percent of the national average, \$34,757. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.9 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 6.9 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Aleutians West Census Area was \$27,038 and ranked 7th in the state. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 0.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.6 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2005 Aleutians West Census Area had a total personal income (TPI) of \$152,736*. This TPI ranked 18th in the state and accounted for 0.6 percent of the state total. In 1995 the TPI of Aleutians West Census Area was \$161,254* and ranked 14th in the state. The 2005 TPI reflected an increase of 5.6 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 8.2 percent and the national change was 5.9 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was - 0.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.6 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Aleutians West Census Area. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 80.4 percent of TPI (compared with 83.4 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 10.2 percent (compared with 10.4 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 9.4 percent (compared with 6.2 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings increased 5.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 7.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.1 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings decreased on average 0.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 0.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 3.7 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Aleutians West Census Area increased from \$204,426* in 2004 to \$216,254* in 2005, an increase of 5.8 percent. The 2004-2005 state change was 6.5 percent and the national change was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$229,985* to the 2005 estimate was - 0.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.5 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
