



BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005 Crowley , Colorado [08025]

Crowley is one of 64 counties in Colorado. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2005 population of 5,951 ranked 47th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2005 Crowley had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$15,905. This PCPI ranked 64th in the state and was 42 percent of the state average, \$37,600, and 46 percent of the national average, \$34,757. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 9.8 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 5.8 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Crowley was \$13,797 and ranked 62nd in the state. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 1.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.5 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2005 Crowley had a total personal income (TPI) of \$94,649*. This TPI ranked 55th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1995 the TPI of Crowley was \$64,045* and ranked 53rd in the state. The 2005 TPI reflected an increase of 10.2 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 7.3 percent and the national change was 5.9 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.6 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Crowley. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 64.0 percent of TPI (compared with 58.5 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 9.7 percent (compared with 16.8 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 26.3 percent (compared with 24.7 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings increased 19.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 18.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.5 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 4.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 1.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.6 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Crowley increased from \$58,348* in 2004 to \$68,671* in 2005, an increase of 17.7 percent. The 2004-2005 state change was 6.5 percent and the national change was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$42,981* to the 2005 estimate was 4.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.0 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
