



## **BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005**

### **Owen , Indiana [18119]**

Owen is one of 92 counties in Indiana. It is part of the [Bloomington, IN \(MSA\)](#). Its 2005 population of 22,383 ranked 68th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Owen had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$24,208. This PCPI ranked 81st in the state and was 78 percent of the state average, \$30,900, and 70 percent of the national average, \$34,757. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.3 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 3.2 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Owen was \$15,943 and ranked 89th in the state. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.7 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Owen had a total personal income (TPI) of \$541,850\*. This TPI ranked 69th in the state and accounted for 0.3 percent of the state total. In 1995 the TPI of Owen was \$320,108\* and ranked 75th in the state. The 2005 TPI reflected an increase of 1.6 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 3.8 percent and the national change was 5.9 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Owen. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 68.4 percent of TPI (compared with 69.2 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 11.4 percent (compared with 14.2 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 20.2 percent (compared with 16.5 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings increased 0.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 6.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 9.7 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 5.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Owen increased from \$204,958\* in 2004 to \$211,231\* in 2005, an increase of 3.1 percent. The 2004-2005 state change was 3.2 percent and the national change was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$110,359\* to the 2005 estimate was 6.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.5 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
