



BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005

Beauregard , Louisiana [22011]

Beauregard is one of 64 counties in Louisiana. It is part of the De Ridder, LA Micropolitan SA. Its 2005 population of 34,264 ranked 32nd in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2005 Beauregard had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$20,603. This PCPI ranked 51st in the state and was 83 percent of the state average, \$24,901, and 59 percent of the national average, \$34,757. The 2005 PCPI reflected a decrease of 6.1 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was -8.7 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Beauregard was \$16,547 and ranked 24th in the state. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 2.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 2.7 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2005 Beauregard had a total personal income (TPI) of \$705,957*. This TPI ranked 31st in the state and accounted for 0.6 percent of the state total. In 1995 the TPI of Beauregard was \$525,624* and ranked 31st in the state. The 2005 TPI reflected a decrease of 4.7 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was - 8.5 percent and the national change was 5.9 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.0 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Beauregard. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 69.1 percent of TPI (compared with 67.2 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 0.1 percent (compared with 13.8 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 30.7 percent (compared with 19.1 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings increased 0.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 99.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 36.4 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 3.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 35.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 8.0 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Beauregard decreased from \$380,918* in 2004 to \$363,530* in 2005, a decrease of 4.6 percent. The 2004-2005 state change was - 1.3 percent and the national change was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$292,543* to the 2005 estimate was 2.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
