



## **BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005**

### **Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville (MSA) [40900]**

Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2005 population of 2,037,871 ranked 26th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$35,318. This PCPI ranked 72nd in the United States and was 102 percent of the national average, \$34,757. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.6 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 national change was 4.9 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville was \$23,397 and ranked 76th in the United States. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville had a total personal income (TPI) of \$71,973,903\*. This TPI ranked 27th in the United States. In 1995 the TPI of Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville was \$38,490,600\* and ranked 28th in the United States. The 2005 TPI reflected an increase of 5.9 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 national change was 5.9 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.3 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 71.3 percent of TPI (compared with 67.6 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 14.5 percent (compared with 17.8 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 14.2 percent (compared with 14.7 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings increased 7.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 0.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.2 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 7.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.1 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville increased from \$54,203,953\* in 2004 to \$58,110,462\* in 2005, an increase of 7.2 percent. The 2004-2005 national change was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$29,092,593\* to the 2005 estimate was 7.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.5 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
