



BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005

Jones , Texas [48253]

Jones is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is part of the [Abilene, TX \(MSA\)](#). Its 2005 population of 19,561 ranked 118th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2005 Jones had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$20,642. This PCPI ranked 221st in the state and was 62 percent of the state average, \$33,253, and 59 percent of the national average, \$34,757. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.5 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 7.4 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Jones was \$12,971 and ranked 230th in the state. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2005 Jones had a total personal income (TPI) of \$403,773*. This TPI ranked 132nd in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1995 the TPI of Jones was \$254,212* and ranked 131st in the state. The 2005 TPI reflected an increase of 5.5 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 9.3 percent and the national change was 5.9 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.7 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Jones. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 63.7 percent of TPI (compared with 56.4 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 10.1 percent (compared with 17.2 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 26.2 percent (compared with 26.4 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings increased 5.9 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 1.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 7.3 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 6.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 0.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.6 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Jones increased from \$194,620* in 2004 to \$212,447* in 2005, an increase of 9.2 percent. The 2004-2005 state change was 7.6 percent and the national change was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$142,159* to the 2005 estimate was 4.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.9 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
