



## **State BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003 District of Columbia**

The population of District of Columbia in 2003 was 577,467.

### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 District of Columbia had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$46,607. This PCPI was 148 percent of the national average, \$31,504. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.7 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of District of Columbia was \$29,996. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.0 percent.

### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 District of Columbia had a total personal income (TPI) of \$26,913,785\*. In 1993 the TPI of District of Columbia was \$17,856,852\*. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 4.4 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.1 percent.

### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and total personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of District of Columbia. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 73.1 percent of TPI (compared with 67.8 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 14.2 percent (compared with 18.8 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 12.6 percent (compared with 13.4 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 5.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 0.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.4 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 5.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 3.6 percent.

### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in District of Columbia increased from \$55,074,933\* in 2002 to \$57,450,759\* in 2003, an increase of 4.3 percent. The 2002-2003 national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$38,062,483\* to the 2003 estimate was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.3 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
