- * The May goods and services deficit (\$75.1 billion) was the highest since October 2022 (\$75.3 billion).
 - * The May goods deficit (\$100.2 billion) was the highest since May 2022 (\$103.7 billion).
- * The May services surplus (\$25.1 billion) was the highest since November 2019 (\$25.7 billion).
- * May exports of services (\$92.1 billion) were the highest on record.
- * May imports of services (\$67.0 billion) were the highest on record.

* May imports of other goods (\$11.4 billion) were the highest since December 2021 (\$11.5 billion).

Real Dollar Basis (Chained 2017 Dollars, seasonally adjusted) Imports

* May real dollar imports of other goods (\$10.1 billion) were the highest since December 2021 (\$10.4 billion).

Country and Other Highlights (Census Basis, not seasonally adjusted)

Balance

- * The May deficit with Mexico (\$14.8 billion) was the highest on record.
- * The May deficit with Taiwan (\$5.5 billion) was the highest on record.

Imports

- * May imports from Mexico (\$43.9 billion) were the highest on record.
- * May imports from Italy (\$7.0 billion) were the highest on record.
- * May imports from South Korea (\$12.3 billion) were the highest on record.
- * The May quantity of crude oil imports (212.0 million barrels) was the highest since July 2019 (214.0 million barrels).
