Goods (Census Basis, seasonally adjusted)

Imports

- * July imports of capital goods (\$140.3 billion) were the highest on record.

Real Dollar Basis (Chained 2017 Dollars, seasonally adjusted)

Imports

- * July real dollar imports of capital goods (\$117.2 billion) were the highest on record.
- * July real dollar imports of petroleum (\$10.3 billion) were the lowest since April 2020 (\$10.2 billion).

Country and Other Highlights (Census Basis, not seasonally adjusted)

Balance

- * The July deficit with Mexico (\$26.3 billion) was the highest on record.
- * The July deficit with Vietnam (\$24.8 billion) was the highest on record.
- * The July deficit with Taiwan (\$20.7 billion) was the highest on record.
- * The July deficit with Thailand (\$12.2 billion) was the highest on record.
- * The July deficit with South Korea (\$10.5 billion) was the highest on record.
- * The July deficit with Malaysia (\$4.9 billion) was the highest on record.

Exports

- * July exports to Brazil (\$5.4 billion) were the highest on record.

Imports

- * July imports from Mexico (\$60.5 billion) were the highest on record.
- * July imports from Vietnam (\$26.4 billion) were the highest on record.
- * July imports from Taiwan (\$25.7 billion) were the highest on record.
- * July imports from South Korea (\$16.7 billion) were the highest on record.
- * July imports from Thailand (\$14.0 billion) were the highest on record.
